How to divide a number by 1 and itself

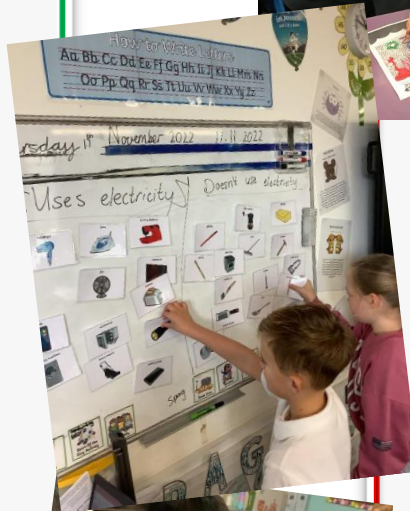
English

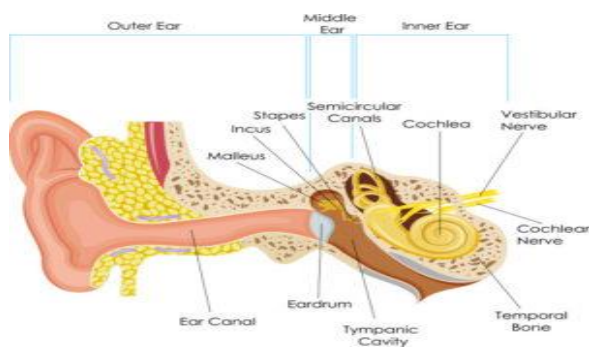
