
Willow Class Celebration Newsletter

In Maths we have started multiplication and division. We have begun to look at arrays and how we can use these. The children are really growing in confidence with repeated addition and multiplication questions.



We were lucky enough to watch a pantomine in the hall as a whole school and we enjoyed learning about jam during guided reading!


