Term 1

In Maths our focus for the term has been on Number and place value as well as doing addition and subtraction and multiplying and dividing 4 digit numbers by 2 digit numbers. After a busy term we can:

- Read, write, compare and order numbers up to 1,000,000.
- Round numbers up to one million.
- Count in powers of 10, 100 and 1000, 10000, and 100000.
- Interpret negative numbers and count backwards and forwards through zero.

In Literacy we read 'Who Let the God's Out', where we met young Elliot. Poor Elliot had the responsibility of looking after his poorly mother as well as juggling school life and trying to pay the bills so they didn't lose their home. Our writing skills have included writing character and setting descriptions, creating non-chronological reports, and writing poetry.

In Science we have been looking at Forces. We have explored how gravitational pull can be measured in newtons, how surface area can have an impact and created our own parachutes to test our theories.

In ICT we have explored computing systems and networks as well as gathered research for our own nonchronological reports.

For our P.E this term we improved our skills in tag rugby and played benchball too, which everyone thoroughly enjoyed.

Topic for Term 1 was history which included learning about Ancient Greeks. We learnt about the Ancient Greek timeline, what life was life during this time and got hands on with many artefacts.

In R.E we discussed what God meant to us and what God represents.

We have been very 'heartsmart' this term and shared what makes us, us!, what makes us happy and what we enjoy.
