Curriculum Information

Our Topic for Term 2 is: 'Our Wonderful World'.

Our Topic work next term will be **Geography based** and will focus on naming and locating the countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and the world's seven continents and five oceans. We will also be using atlases and maps and looking at human and physical features of the local area.

<u>Science</u>— we will be continuing to learn all about materials and why some materials are best suited to certain objects.

<u>English</u>— we will be learning how to use different conjunctions and noun phrases to expand our sentences through our English work on our new termly book and in our poetry work on fireworks night.

<u>Maths</u>—we will be learning different strategies to add and subtract two or three numbers (this could involve a one digit, two digit or a three digit number). We will continue to solve problems through identifying missing numbers and explain where a mistake has happened (reasoning). Later in the term our maths will focus on 2D and 3D shapes. We will continue to reinforce our mental maths skills with our daily Tough Ten questions.

Art—we will be looking at the work of Marela Zacarías and Vincent van Gogh.
