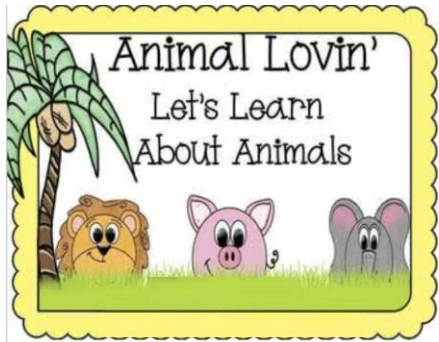

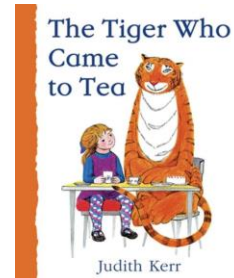
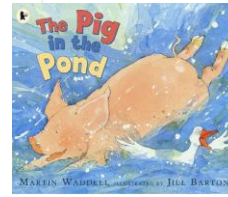
Writing - We will begin to write initial sound of words when annotating our pictures. Please continue to support your child at home, if they are not yet able to write their own name.
