



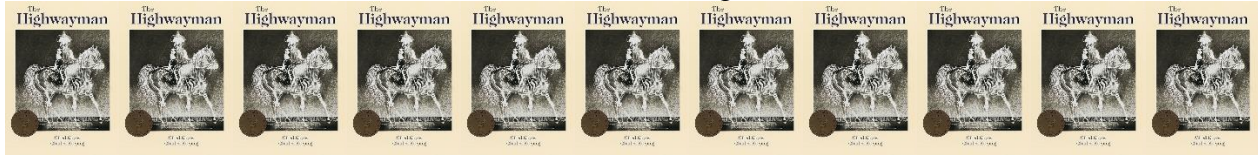
# What is happening in Oak class in Term 3?



## English

This term's text is The Highwayman by Alfred Noyes.

We shall be using this narrative poem in a number of ways including creating our own poems, drama and dramatic writing.



## History

We will be starting a new unit in term 3, both new to the class and the school. In this crime and punishment unit, children will build on their knowledge of periods in history that they have studied through KS2. Children will explore using different historical disciplinary concepts, how crime and punishment has changed over time in Britain. They will explore what was seen as a crime over time and the different gruesome punishments that were handed out to criminals. The children will find out about the development of the police force from the Victorian period right through to the new millennium.
