LOOKING FORWARD TO NEXT TERM:

ENGLISH

MATHS

In maths we will begin place value within 50 before moving on to multiplication and division.

SCIENCE

In science we will continue with our topic, 'Plants'. We will be identifying the parts of trees and explaining their functions as well as identifying some common wild and garden plants and continuing to consolidate our understanding of what a plant needs to grow.

HISTORY

Our topic in history in term 5 will be 'Explorers.' We will be using the following vocabulary: explore, explorer, significant, changes, then, now, before, past, present, same, different, monument, astronaut, mountaineer, oceanographer.
