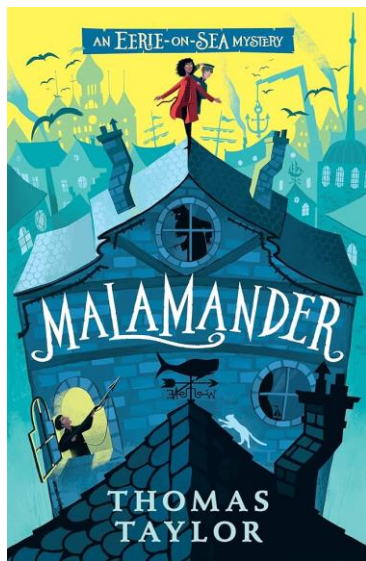


What is happening in Beech class in Term 6?



English

Our Geography unit will complement our final trip of the year – details to follow. We would like the children to experience different biomes and environments!



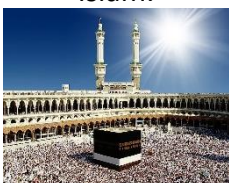
Maths

We will be finishing the shape topic and moving on to position & direction and then decimals.

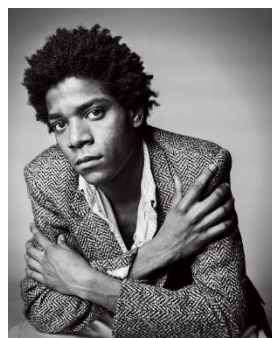
The final reading and maths assessments will also take place this term.
