We have a busy term to look forward to.

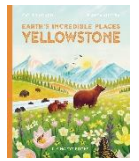
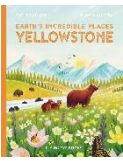
During the second week of term, we shall be off on our five days of trips - if you need another form, just let us know. Both the form and payment need to be in on the first day back of term.

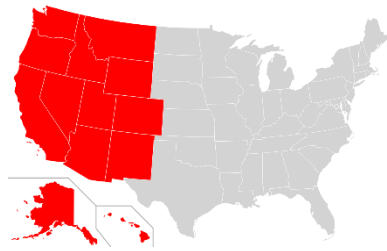

English

Geography



We will be returning to our unit comparing the UK with the western United States, which we started back in Term 2. The children will be looking at various physical and human geography features and comparing them to similar features in our own region.

The children will continue with their weekly ukulele lesson, building on the skills that they have been practising since their introduction to the instrument in Year 5 as well as developing their understanding of composition.

Art

In art we will be looking at the work of David Krakov and creating a 3D sculpture inspired by his work.

The children will be starting their Kingdom of God unit, where they will be considering the question - What kind of king is Jesus?

Day 1 ~ A trip to Mote Park in Maidstone where the children will have a session on the Sky Trail, the climbing wall, mini golf and the adventure playground.

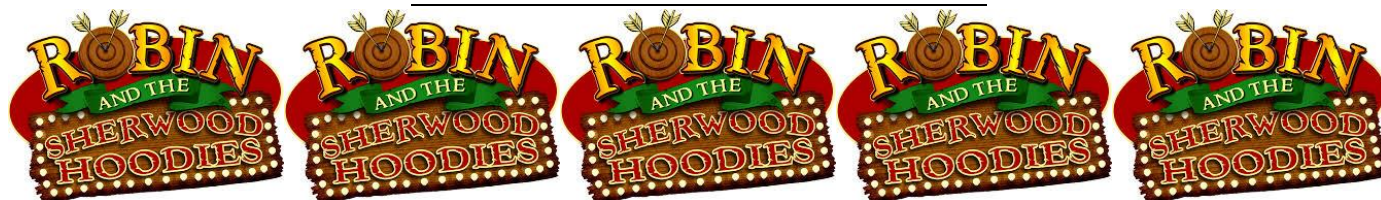
Day 2 ~ A day at Riverside Park taking part in pond dipping, a mini beast trail, orienteering and a session in the play area.
