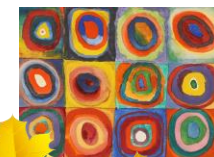
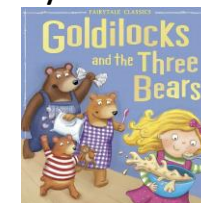
Terrific Tales & Celebrations

Communication, Language and Literacy - We will be thinking about and enjoying some of our favourite books and stories. These may include traditional fairy tales and other classic texts. We will be performing and retelling stories through role play and small world play too.

Phonics - We will continue with the great start we have made in phonics, learning more phonemes and practising the skill of orally blending and segmenting. In **Writing** we will focus on developing our fine motor skills through the Dough Disco and Write Dance programmes.

Maths - We will continue to develop our subitising and counting skills and explore composition of number within and beyond 5. We will identify when two sets are equal or unequal and connect two equal groups to doubles. We will use the artist Kandinsky to learn about shape.

Understanding of the World - We will continue to learn about the world around us through celebrations such as Diwali, Remembrance and Christmas.
