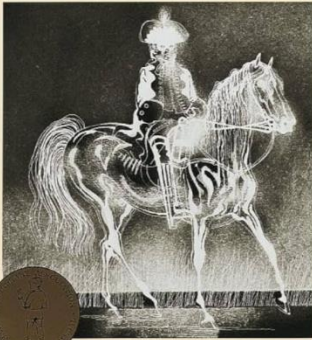


# What is happening in **Oak Class** in Term 3?
