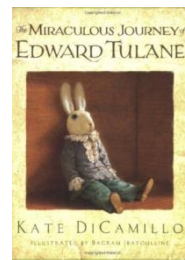


Hawthorn class

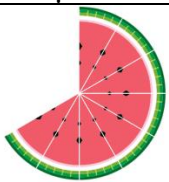
Looking forward to term 4.
