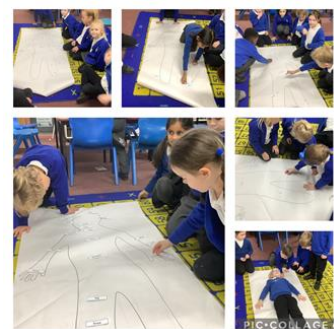
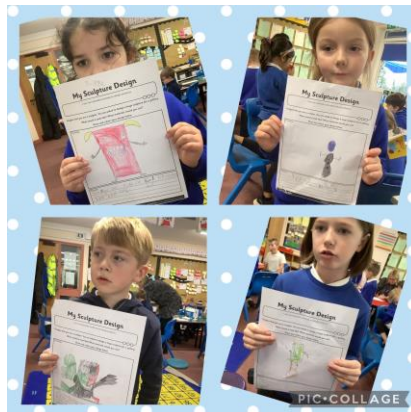
What a busy term!

We have enjoyed getting creative in our art lessons this term, linking our Science topic of Animals including Humans with our recycled sculptures inspired by the artist Michelle Reader.



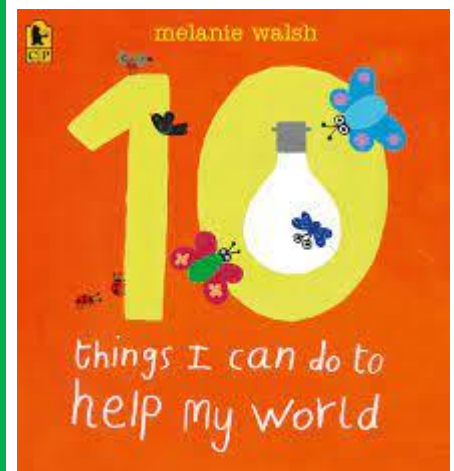
