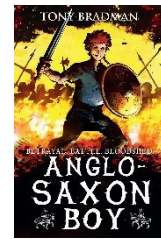


# Hawthorn class

## English

We will be reading *Anglo Saxon Boy* by Tony Bradman. This story of a boy's journey to the Battle of Hastings in 1066 ties in with our learning in History this term. We will be looking at writing non-chronological reports about this time period.
