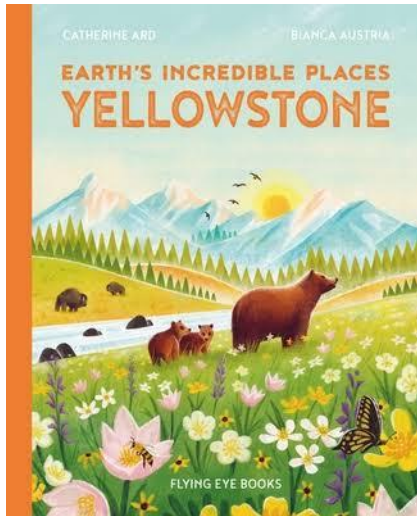


# What is happening in Oak class in Term 6?



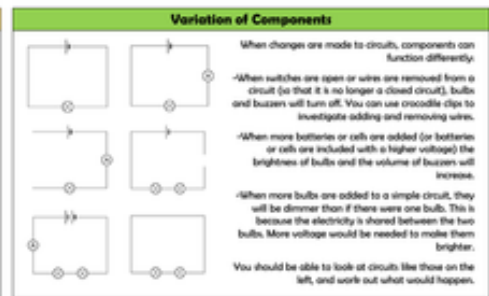
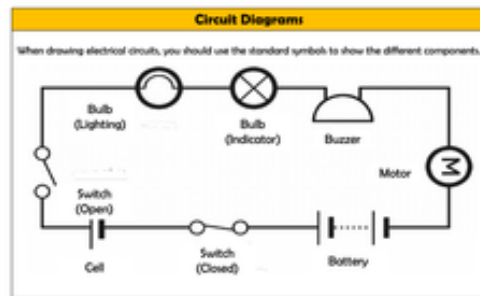
## English

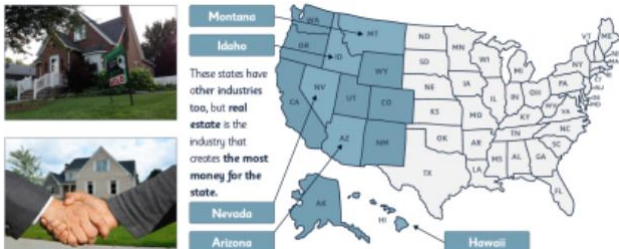
We will use this text to inform our writing in English lessons.

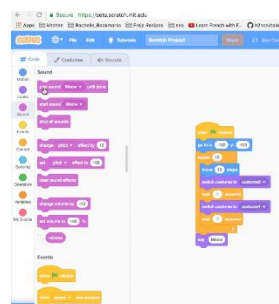
## Maths
