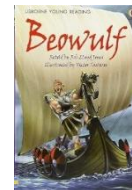


# Hawthorn class

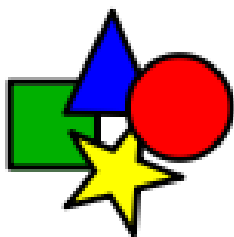
Looking forward to Term 6.

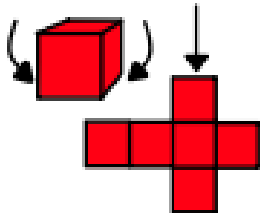
## Science
