ENGLISH

In English we will continuing to use the text 'The Bog Baby' by Jeanne Willis as a vehicle for instructional writing before exploring 'Sportopedia' by Adam Skinner when we will be writing our own non-fiction sports guide.

MATHS

In maths we will secure our knowledge of addition and subtraction before moving onto multiplication and division.

SCIENCE

Our topic in science will be 'living things and their habitats'. We will be using the following vocabulary: living, dead, never been alive, suited, suitable, basic needs, food, food chain, shelter, move, feed, water, air, survive, survival, names of local habitats (e.g. pond, woodland etc.), names of micro-habitats (e.g. under logs, in bushes etc.), conditions, light, dark, shady, sunny, wet, damp, dry, hot and cold.

GEOGRAPHY

We will be begin a new topic, our fieldwork unit 'Weather and Climate'. We will be using the following vocabulary: analyse, atmosphere, axes, bar chart, climate, climate zone, equator, evaluate, forecast, key, meteorologist, mild, okta, pictogram, poles, precipitation, present, rain gauge, reflect, table, temperate, temperature, thermometer, symbol, weather and weathervane.
