For Art we will be learning about Andy Goldsworthy and exploring his methods and artistic style. Then we will try to create our own inspired pieces.

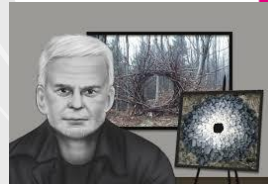
