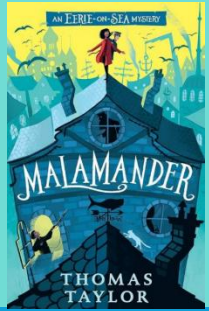


What is happening in Beech Class in Term 6?



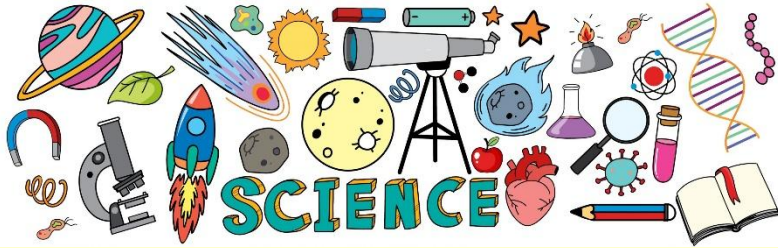
English
